Pellon® Cheesecloth

2 yards

Materials Needed

S.E.I. tumble dye Tension rod Café rod clip set Rubber bands Thread Various colors

Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies

Cut curtain pieces to desired size. Wet the cheesecloth. Secure with rubber bands as desired.




Spray cheesecloth with S.E.I. Tumble Dye.
