Fast, Fun & Easy! A great way to use 5" charm packs to create an interesting scrappy patchwork quilt. Cut apart a simple block & rearrange to make a floating block that is super easy to assemble. No exact intersections to align. Go for it!

Binding	1/2 yd	1/2 yd	3/4 yd	3/4 yd	1 yd

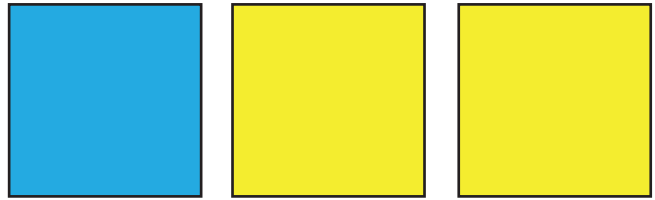

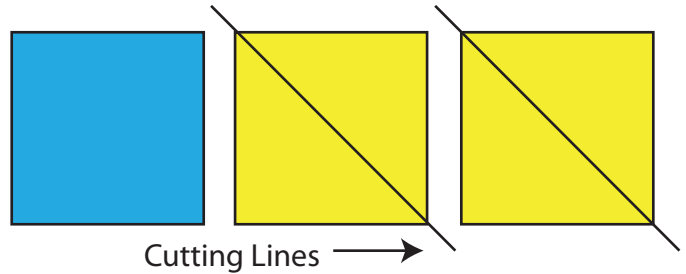
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## Cutting and Stitching Instructions

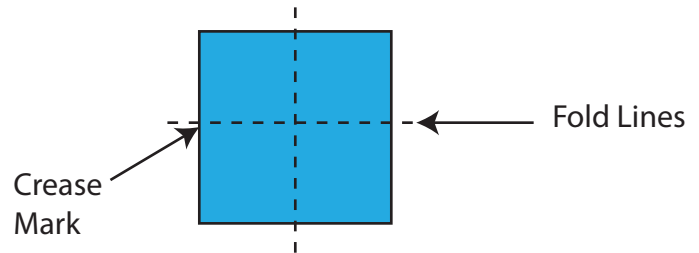
All seam allowances are 1/4". Place one medium or dark square on table. Place two lighter squares on table.



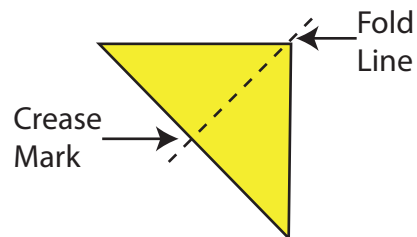
Cut the lighter squares from corner to corner creating triangles.



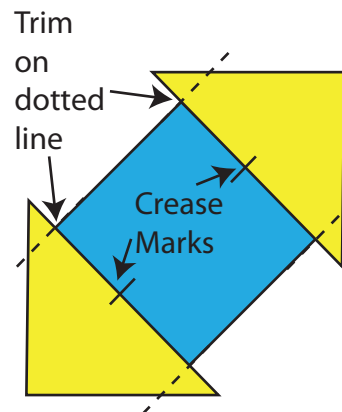
Fold the medium or dark square into quarters and press making a small crease at the midpoints on all 4 sides.



Fold the triangles in half along the LONG side of each one. Place a crease at this location.



Stitch two triangles to opposing sides of the square with right sides together. Use the creased location indicators to align the pieces. Press seam allowances outward toward the triangles. Trim as shown.

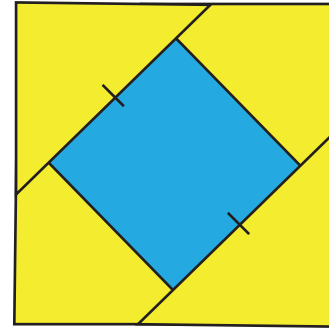


Sew on remaining triangles, aligning the crease marks. Press outward towards triangles. (Unit A)

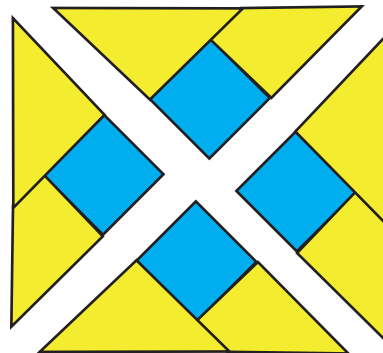
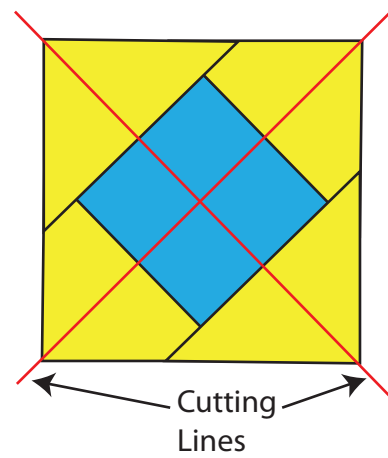

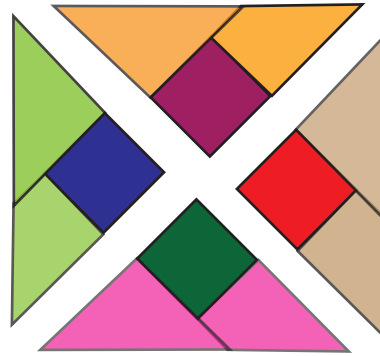
Unit A

Cut Unit A into four quarters as shown (Unit B).

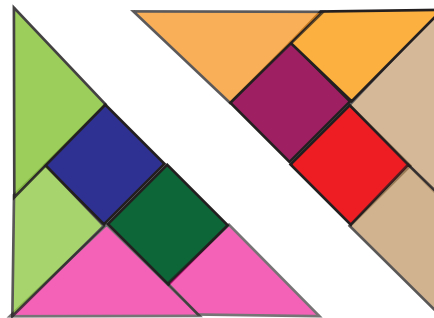


Unit B's

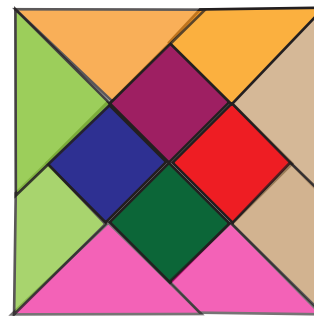
Arrange four assorted unit B's as shown at right.



Stitch Unit B's together. Press seams to the right.



Stitch two halves together. Press seam open.



Sew blocks together to create rows. Sew rows together to create quilt.
