Use Pellon[®] Fusible Fleece to add extra warmth to a jacket or coat lining. Sample used McCall's Pattern M6445, available at your local sewing center.

Fabrics Needed

Outside fabric
Lining fabric

Materials Needed

Pellon[®] 987F Fusible Fleece
Pellon[®] 931TD Fusible Midweight Interfacing for Collar
Lined Coat Pattern
Thread

Sewing machine and related supplies
Iron and ironing board

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Cut out pattern pieces for the outside fabric and the lining fabric. Use the lining and facing pieces as pattern templates to cut out the Fusible Fleece. If making a folded collar and lapel, use interfacing for these pieces and not Fusible Fleece. Pellon® recommends 931TD Fusible Midweight for midweight to heavy-weight fabrics.



Fuse the Fusible Fleece to the lining and facing pieces. Place the Fusible Fleece with the fusible side facing up. Place the lining pieces right side up on top of the Fusible Fleece. Fuse into place following manufacturer's instructions.

If desired, sew with a regulation stitch once or twice in the middle of each large piece to ensure the Fusible Fleece will be anchored to the lining.



Sew the coat together as instructed by the pattern. When trimming seam allowances, trim the Fusible Fleece to 1/8".
