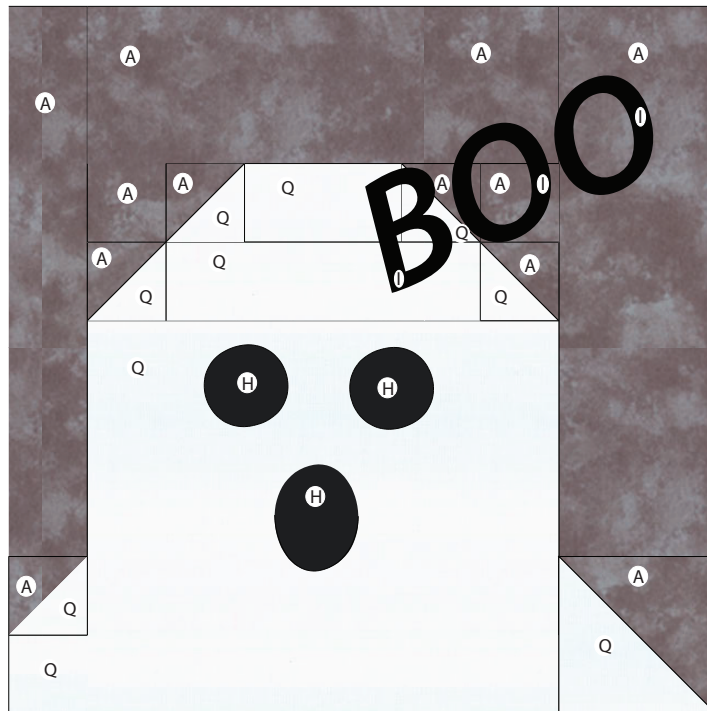


Ghost - Block 2 of 13 - 9" Finished

Refer to Trick or Treat Quilt-a-Long Overview for fabric lettering and requirements.

All seam allowances are 1/4".



Cutting Instructions

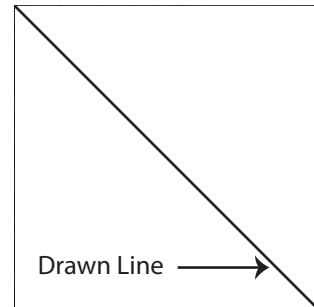

| Fabric A | Cut one 2-7/8" square.
Cut three 1-7/8" squares.
Cut two 1-1/2" squares.
Cut one 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle.
Cut one 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle.
Cut one 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle. |
| Fabric H | Cut eyes and mouth for applique (see templates on page 5). |
| Fabric I | Cut lettering for Boo (see templates on page 5). |
| Fabric Q | Cut one 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle.
Cut one 2-7/8" square.
Cut one 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.
Cut one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle.
Cut three 1-7/8" squares.
Cut one 1-1/2" square. |

Half Square Triangles

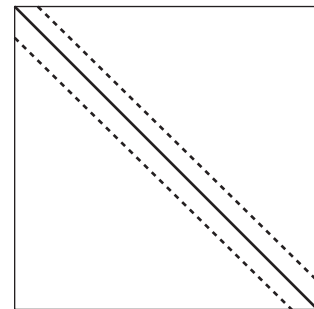
Make half square triangles by placing two 1-7/8" squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line as shown on the lighter of two squares. Squares to place together are shown below.

Fabric A/Fabric Q

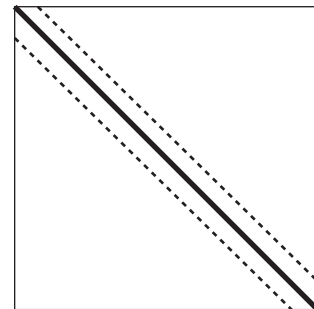
Make three



Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.



Cut on the drawn line.



Press seam towards the darker of the two fabrics. Half square triangle units made shown at right.



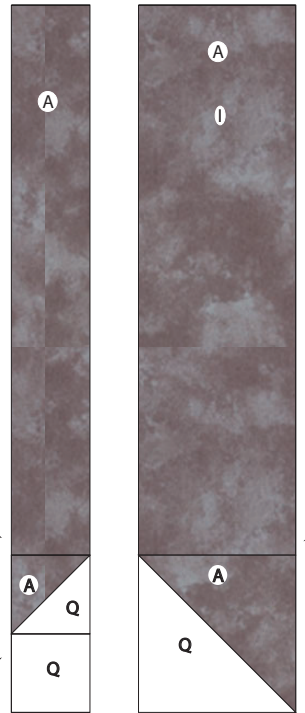
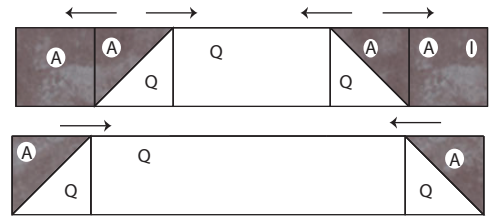
Repeat these steps and make one HST using the 2-7/8" square of fabric A and fabric Q.



Sew the half square triangle (HST) units to the fabric pieces as shown at right.

- Fabric A 1-1/2" squares to the smaller HST A/Q as shown
- Fabric Q 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" to the previous step
- Fabric Q 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" to the smaller HST A/Q as shown
- Fabric A 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" to the smaller HST A/Q as shown
- Fabric Q 1-1/2" square to the previous step
- Fabric A 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" to the larger HST A/Q

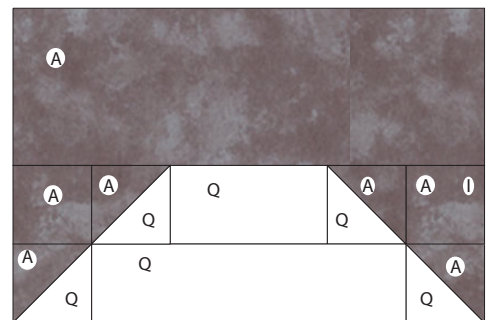
Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



Sew the pieces shown at right to the units.

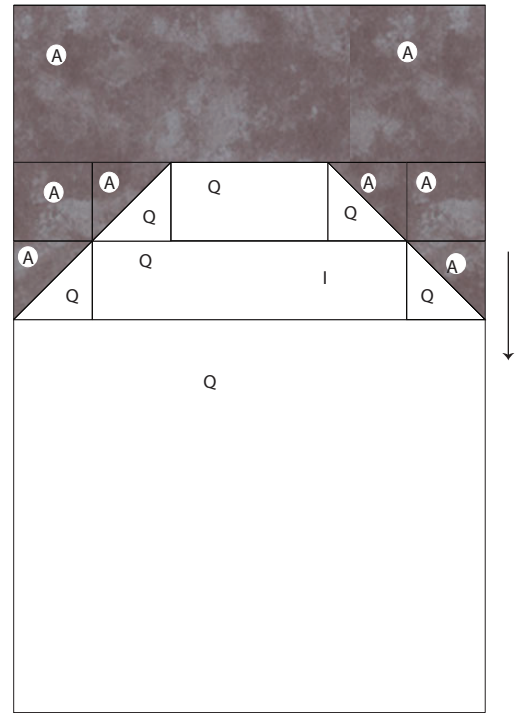
- Fabric A 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" to the unit shown at right.
- Sew the two units made in the previous step as shown at right.

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



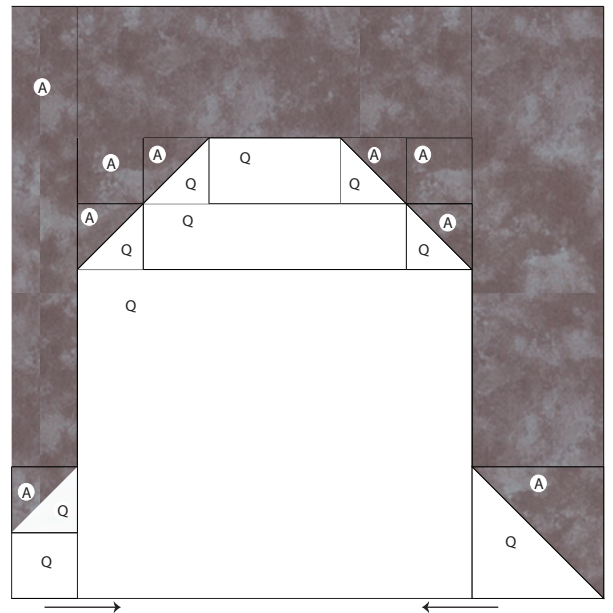
Sew the fabric Q $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the block as shown at right.

Press seam in the direction of the arrow.



Sew the two units made earlier to the block as shown at right.

Press seams in the direction of the arrows.



For machine applique, trace the templates below onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under®. Fuse the Wonder-Under® to the wrong side of the fabrics for the eyes, mouth and the lettering. Use the backward letters for the BOO. Cut out the applique pieces. Remove the paper and fuse into place on the block. Finish the edges with either a straight or zigzag stitch.

For hand applique use the templates below, add a scant seam allowance and stitch using a favorite applique method.
