Dog Collar + Easy Optional Leash Skill Level: Beginner

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Cute and fast, this easily customized dog collar and leash set will make a great beginner sewing project or a quick gift for your favorite pooch.

Fabrics Needed

Cotton collar fabric	1/8 yard
Leash fabric (optional)	1/4 yard straight cut

Materials Needed

Pellon® 911FF Fusible Featherweight Interfacing	1 yard
Thread	
One 3/4" side-release buckle	
One 3/4" D-ring	
One wide mouth single bar slide	
One 3/4" leash clip (optional for leash)	

Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies
Rotary cutter and related supplies

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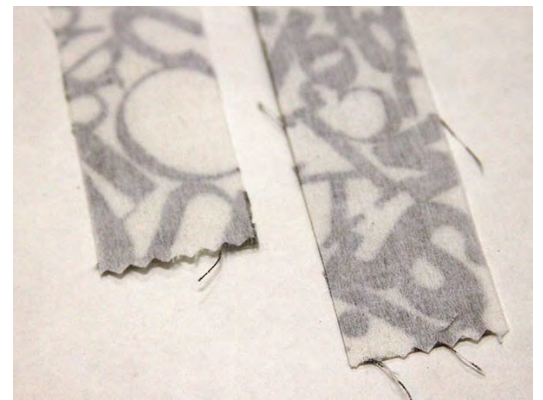
Cut two 1-1/4" x 24" strips for collar. If piecing multiple lengths of fabric, attach diagonally to reduce bulk.

Cut two 1-1/4" x 24" strips of 911FF Fusible Featherweight.

Fuse the Fusible Featherweight to the wrong side of both collar pieces following manufacturer's instructions.

Place the two collar pieces right sides together. Stitch around three sides of the collar using a 1/4" seam allowance. Leave one narrow end open for turning.

Turn collar right side out.



Press collar. Topstitch 1/8" from the edge of the collar.



Assembling the Collar



Assemble the collar shown. Pin ends to secure before sewing. Remove one pin at a time and use a narrow, dense, zigzag stitch to secure the ends of the collar.



Optional Leash

Cut two 1-1/4" x 84" strips of fabric and one 1-1/4" x 84" Fusible Featherweight Interfacing. Butt strips of interfacing to make the length.

Repeat steps as for collar. Secure the leash clip with a tight zigzag stitch. Fold over and secure a loop at the opposite end for the handle.
